We, the parents of Fairview/Clements Theme Schools, commit to serve as collaborators with the faculty, administration, and students to achieve excellence in the educational goals for our children through academic, social, moral, and vocational participation.

As parent/guardian for the above mentioned student, I pledge to do the following:

1. Sign the parent volunteer contract committing 10 hours per semester per household, for a total of 20 hours per year, to be completed by May 15, 2010. If your family has one or more students attending both Fairview and Clements, each family is responsible for 5 hours per semester and 10 hours per year at each school.
2. Actively support the Trailblazer Community Council organization.
3. Strictly enforce the established uniform dress code as outlined in the parent/student handbook.
4. Ensure that student arrives on time daily and avoids unnecessary checkouts.
5. Check in at the office during each visit to the school, as required by Newton County School System policy, to ensure the safety of all children and staff.
6. Strictly enforce the system's and the school's conduct codes and policies. Actively work with the child and school if discipline problems occur. Students causing continued disruptions will be required to go before the administration of the school and/or a district administrative panel for a decision of the student's right to continue at the theme school.
7. Require a minimum of 15-30 minutes of daily reading at home.
8. Support daily classwork, homework, and project requirements.
9. Facilitate the home/school communication effort by monitoring and enforcing the use of the agenda planner by the student, parent, and teacher.
10. Ensure that students participating in extracurricular activities are picked up on time, as indicated by the permission slip.
11. Attend a minimum of one in-school parent/teacher conference per semester to discuss your student's progress and other conferences as requested by the school. Attend SST, IEP, and RTI meetings as required.
12. Submit updated student and parent information to the school office within forty-eight hours of making changes (such as emergency contact information changes, permanent transportation changes, and address changes).
